2007 CONCACAF COPA ORO EXCLUSIVE SPANISH-LANGUAGE TELEVISION COVERAGE ON UNIVISION, TELEFUTURA, AND GALAVISIÓN TO START WEDNESDAY, JUNE 6

WHAT: Univision, TeleFutura, and Galavisión will provide exclusive Spanish-language coverage of the 2007 CONCACAF Copa Oro (Gold Cup) North and Central America championship tournament live from venues in Los Angeles, New York, Miami, Chicago, Boston, and Houston.

INFORMATION: Some of the most contentious rivalries in soccer will be on display starting June 6th when teams meet to compete for the prestigious Gold Cup. Six of the games will be televised on Univision, 11 on TeleFutura, and 8 on Galavisión.
