



UNIVISION'S COUNTDOWN TO THE WORLD CUP CONTINUES WITH EXCLUSIVE LIVE COVERAGE OF THE 2009 CONCACAF GOLD CUP

**Exciting Tournament Kickoff Begins Friday, July 3;
USA and Mexico National Teams Play First Tournament Matches on Saturday and Sunday**

Sports Filled Sunday Culminates with Univision's Broadcast of the Second Annual "Tecate Premios Deportes" Sports Awards

MIAMI, FL – JULY 2, 2009 – The networks of Univision announced today the schedule for their exclusive Spanish-language coverage of all the games to be played during the CONCACAF Gold Cup™ 2009, the biennial tournament and premier event for FIFA's North America, Central America and Caribbean confederation. Continuing the countdown to the 2010 FIFA World Cup South Africa™, Univision, TeleFutura and Galavisión bring soccer fans the one of the most anticipated soccer tournaments of the summer. Beginning on Friday, July 3, all three networks will offer the most complete coverage of this exciting event all the way up to its final match on Sunday, July 26 LIVE from New York.

Established in 1991, the Gold Cup has become the region's most popular soccer event, routinely drawing capacity crowds and millions of viewers across the nation. Throughout the years the Gold Cup finals have grown into a 12-nation championship with countries qualifying from the three regions of CONCACAF, North America, Central America (UNCAF) and the Caribbean (Caribbean Football Union). The tournament features the best players from the region, with Mexico and the United States holding the most Gold Cup titles. Hosted in the United States this year the 12 teams that will face off in the 2009 tournament are: Canada, Costa Rica, El Salvador, Grenada, Guadeloupe, Haiti, Honduras, Jamaica, Mexico, Nicaragua, Panama and United States.

All the excitement of the Gold Cup will begin on Friday, July 3 with Canada vs. Jamaica (Galavisión), followed by Costa Rica vs. El Salvador (TeleFutura). The action continues on Saturday, July 4th with Honduras vs. Haiti (Galavisión) and later, playing their first game in the tournament on the nation's most celebrated holiday, the U.S. team will play against Grenada (TeleFutura). On Sunday, July 5th Panama will play vs. Guadeloupe (Galavisión), while the Mexican national team will make its much anticipated tournament debut later that day playing against Nicaragua (Univision).

Univision will culminate the sports-filled weekend with the broadcast of the second annual "Tecate Premios Deportes" Sports Awards (Sunday July 5 at 9pm ET/PT, 8pm Central) held at Los Angeles' historic Orpheum theater. Sports idols such as **Oscar de la Hoya, Julio César Chávez, Juan Manuel Márquez, Roberto Durán** and **Luis Castillo**, among others, as well as celebrities such as **Gloria Trevi, Cristian Castro, Lupillo Rivera, Beto Cuevas, Khriz y Angel, La Arrolladora Banda el Limón, Fanny Lú** and **Patrulla 81** will be present to honor Hispanic sports' heroes for their athletic excellence and exemplary career. In addition, the versatile actress

Angélica Vale, television heartthrob **Cristián de la Fuente** and Univision's "República Deportiva" (Sports Republic) "President" **Fernando Fiore** will host an entertaining evening filled with humor and surprises.
